1. Call to order.

- 6. Discussion and possible action concerning:
 - (a) Authorizing the Town Attorney to obtain updated abstracts for Town properties located at 522 W. Cresthaven Avenue, Porter, and 51050 Hwy 51B, Tullahassee, upon which are located water towers and Tullahassee storage tank.

Town attorney Tammy Ewing said if the Authority has to borrow money for water improvements, the lender will want to use the water towers and storage tank as collateral. She said the title company needs proof that Porter owns the land. Ms. Ewing said the abstracts are not up to date. She said there are two abstracts that need to be updated. She said it will cost approximately \$1,000.00 per abstract. Motion was made by Bradah Littlefield to proceed with obtaining updated abstracts. The motion was seconded by Whitney Littlefield. Jackie Todd said there is a builder that wants to build homes on Tullahassee Loop road. Jackie said the builder said he will probably need eleven new water taps. Jackie said the Authority had requests for five new taps this month. He said there is a person talking about putting in an RV park on Highway 69. He said this RV park will have 70 hook-ups. Jackie said the Authority had a water loss of 800,000 gallons of water in October, mainly due to leaks and flushing the water lines.
